Mon 23rd	Open Doors "...God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation." (2 Corinthians 5:19) [NIV] Please pray for: Eun-Yeong, (N.Korea) who has spent yet another Christmas in a labour camp, because of her faith. She may never see her children again: A breakthrough this year in the situation for Christians in North Korea. Pray also: That followers of Jesus in the Muslim world will live out their faith courageously and without fear & that Christian/Muslim relationships will improve, particularly in Nigeria and North African countries. Pray: That throughout 2012 God "Will strengthen what remains and is about to die" (Rev.3:2)
Tues 24th	Pray & Give thanks for: Willis & Mark as they prepare for Sunday services, visit homes and hospitals. May God grant them health, strength and energy for each day's task and may the Holy Spirit continue to work out His purpose through them. Continue to Pray for: Those who are sick, may God minister His healing touch to each one.
