MON 24th	The Word of God is living and active. Sharper than any two edge sword... it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Heb.4:12 ` Ever present truest Friend, ever near, Your aid to lend. Guide us as we search the Word, make it both our shield and sword`. May we let God`s Word explore our inner being. Give thanks for: The teaching and preaching we receive each week.
TUES 25th	Pray: Willis and Mark would know the guidance of the Holy Spirit as they prepare for the Sunday Services and Mid Week Fellowship and that God would bless, encourage and enable them to do the work He has called them to do. Pray for: Those who have been bereaved, may they know the `peace of God which passes all understanding` and be comforted; Those who are sick, may God in His mercy be pleased to stretch forth His mighty healing hand and restore their health for His glory.
WED 26th	Pray for: The people of Thailand who have been affected by the devastating and widespread flooding. Pray: That much needed aid would reach isolated areas, and those who have been cut off by flood waters would be rescued. Pray for: Those who have been bereaved, injured or lost everything that they would be comforted and their needs met. Pray: That the heavy monsoon rains would stop and that the flooding would dry up enabling the people to rebuild their lives.
THUR 27th	PRAY: That more people in UK churches would access the Christian Aid and Tearfund Prayer Diaries so that each week many more would know the specific needs in each country and be equipped to pray into urgent situations as well as ongoing projects. Give thanks for: The prayer support groups meeting monthly across the nation and the prayer warriors who faithfully uphold their work daily.
FRI 28th	PCI Home Mission: Pray for: Michael Anderson and the congregation in Arklow who are meeting in other premises as their church is being renovated. Give thanks for: The progress of the building work. Pray for: The vacant Home Mission Congregations of Wexford & Enniscorthy. Continue to remember the work of Nightlight on the Golden Mile and at the Odyssey Arena Belfast on Friday & Saturday nights.
SAT 29th	Radio Bible Class Ministries (RBC) Give thanks for: This worldwide ministry. <u>Russia</u>: Praise God for: Continued access to hospitals, schools, rehabilitation centres and orphanages. Pray for: The ongoing work in each of these areas. <u>Italian & Dutch Language</u>: Give thanks for: The translation of Discovery Series books into Italian & Dutch; the faithfulness of translators, editors and proofreaders. Pray for: Ways to raise awareness of resources, increased contacts with churches.
SUN 30th	There are an estimated 145million orphans globally mainly in Africa, Asia and Latin America. PRAY: God would encourage a growing network of churches with Tearfund to respond to care for these orphaned children, thus fulfilling Gods command to look after widows and orphans. PRAISE God for: Their Inspired Individuals Programme –for Naomi Hendricks, tirelessly working in Mumbai with street children and Caleb Rukundo, a former street child in Kampala, Uganda giving the children a safe house and an extended family who love them. “THANK YOU Father that you can transform lives even from the toughest beginnings.”
